ST. MARY'S ANNUAL MEMORIAL MASS

On Friday, November 2, All Souls Day at 7:00 p.m., we will celebrate **St. Mary's Annual Memorial Mass.**



At this Mass, we remember all those who have died this past year. We invite family and friends of the deceased to light a personalized candle which is placed near the altar during the Mass. St. Mary's Bereavement Ministry sent out invitations to those families who have had funerals from St. Mary's in the past year, but we realize that this will not include any of your family or friends who have died outside of the parish.

If you did not receive a letter and you wish to attend and have your family members or friends included, the members of the Bereavement Ministry will be in the hall prior to Mass to offer you a candle and a label so that all your loved ones can be remembered at this Mass. As there may be some congestion, it is suggested that you should come a little early to pick up your candle. The Mass will be followed by a reception in the hall.

VIGIL CANDLES

November traditionally is set aside for honouring the dead. All Souls Day is celebrated on November 2 where we commemorate all the faithful departed. Vigil or Votive Candles signify "our prayer offered in faith coming into the light of God. With the light of faith, we petition our Lord in prayer, or petition the Saint to pray with us and for us to the Lord."



The Vigil Candle symbolizes how a person desires "to remain present to the Lord in prayer even though we may depart" the premises. It reinforces the idea that candles represent our prayers before God. Suggested offering is \$4.00 each and burn for 72 hours approximately.
