

MISSION CO-OPERATIVE PROGRAM

he Archdiocesan Mission Co-Operative Program plays an important role in connecting the parishes of the Archdiocese of Toronto with the Catholic Church in other parts of the world. Through this program, our local Catholic Community learns about the mission work of the Church and is invited to offer their financial support through this annual program.

On the weekend of July 21st and 22nd, we will be welcoming Rev. Maciek Zielinski. Fr. Zielinski is a Comboni Missionary from Poland. His missionary journey started when he was in secondary school with the dream that one day he would like to be a priest and could spread the Good News in distant places in Africa. This dream started to be real in 1998 when he joined the community of Comboni Missionaries in Poland and after 5 years of training, he reached Africa - Kenya for the first time. He spent a year there. Then he went back to Italy to finish his studies. In 2008 he was ordained priest and hoped to go back to Kenya, but he was asked to work first in Poland to look for new missionary vocations, animating the Church in his country. Finally in the beginning of 2015 he came to Kenya, where he is up to now. He is working in Amakuriat, a mission among the Pokot people. This is the land of first evangelization in a remote area, so his dream now became reality.
