



#### **BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE** AND NOVEMBER PRAYER

The Book of Remembrance is available in the church proper so that you may inscribe the names of those who have gone before you marked with the sign of faith. Throughout the month of November, the month of holy souls, we pray for those who died. Although the falling leaves and days that are getting shorter can create a picture of death we know that Jesus in his resurrection has destroyed death for all time. During this month you are invited to light a candle when you gather for a meal or family prayer and to include a prayer for those who have died including those who have no one to pray for them. A traditional prayer for those who have died is:

Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord, And let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, Through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

#### **VIGIL CANDLES**

Vigil or Votive Candles signify "our prayer offered in faith coming into the light of God. With the light of faith, we petition our Lord in prayer, or petition the Saint to pray with us and for us to the Lord." The Vigil Candle symbolizes how a person desires "to remain present to the Lord in prayer even though we may depart" the premises. It reinforces the idea that candles represent our prayers before God. The suggested offering is \$4.00 each and each candle burns for approximately 72 hours.
