e often pray asking that the Kingdom of God may be built up here on earth when we say "thy Kingdom come, thy Will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven." In addition to our practice of praying, we as good stewards can help build up the Kingdom through our deeds. Let us ask ourselves how we can better share our gifts to build up our parish communities and the Kingdom of God.

### A NEW LITURGICAL YEAR: YEAR A

The Church follows a three-year cycle and on the first Sunday of Advent, December 1, 2019 we embark on a new liturgical year. On Sundays during Year A, the Gospel reading will most often be from the gospel of St. Matthew. The new Sunday Missal includes a brief introduction to St. Matthew's gospel.

# **RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION:** A SIGN OF OUR COMMUNION WITH GOD AND UNION WITH OTHERS

Beginning the first Sunday of Advent at every liturgy, we shall be invited to share both the Body and Blood of Christ. It is always good for those of us who come to the table each week to pause and recall the proper way to receive Holy Communion.

At the time of Holy Communion when the person in front of you has received Holy Communion and you are in the front of the procession, you will bow your head, the Minister of the Body of Christ will say, "The Body of Christ", you will reply, "Amen".

It is important to note that the only appropriate response is Amen. The Church expects that Amen is said in a voice that can be heard by the Minister of Holy Communion.

After saying Amen you will consume the host immediately and if receiving the Precious Blood, you will move to the Minister of the Chalice



who will say, "The Blood of Christ", you will reply, "Amen" and take a sip from the chalice.

You will not bow a second time for the act of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ is one ritual gesture. (GIRM, paragraph 160) The Canadian Bishops have instructed that our common sign of reverence be a bow of the head.

As a sign of our unity and respect for the Body of Christ, we join in singing the Communion hymn. After everyone has shared in Holy Communion there will be a time of silence for prayer.
