The undeniable fun and frivolity of the Swedish supergroup ABBA is globally heralded. Their groovy catalog of chart toppers continues to offer dance floor favorites. The band was honoured for the 50th anniversary of their stardom breakthrough at this year's Spring Eurovision held in the city of Malmo in their native land.

However, the best of the best of present European talent showcased at this year's festival presented a dramatic shift from the joviality of a previous generation. Instead, the performers screeched, twerked and writhed their way through unimpressive numbers. The 2024 quality of melody and song failed to match up to past musicianship and entertainment.




